The National Service Scheme of the Thiruvalluvar University started its functioning under the Chairmanship of then Vice-Chancellor of the University from 15.04.2005, it was separated from the NSS Cell of the University of Madras with allotment of 100 units having 10,000 NSS volunteers for the Thiruvalluvar University.

Now, the Thiruvalluvar University NSS Cell is functioning with 125 NSS units having 12,500 NSS Volunteers at 66 affiliated colleges of Thiruvalluvar University. The guidance and chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor Dr.P.Gunasekaran, the NSS Programme Coordinator Dr.R. Jagadheesan implement the Regular activities, Special camping activities and other Government programmes with the support of the Tamil Nadu State NSS Cell and NSS Regional Centre, Government of India, Chennai.

In the University level NSS regular activities like Sadbhavana Diwas, Independence day, NSS Day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Republic day, Personality development programmes for NSS Volunteers, Training programmes for NSS Programme Officers, Tree plantation, Blood donation camp, and HIV/AIDS awareness programmes are carried out in the University. The NSS Cell of Thiruvalluvar University has being mobilized NSS Volunteers and NSS Programme Officers to participate in the National events like Special adventure camp, Mega Summer camp and pilot testing of training manual on human rights and social harmony and Republic Day parade camp every year.

In the College level as a routine NSS Regular activities like Sadbhavana Diwas, NSS Day, Independence day, Republic day, National voters day, Breast feeding day, Consumer awareness day, Environment day, International literacy day, Mothers day, Women's day, Cultural unity day, World AIDS day, General health camp, Medical camp, Eye camp, Dental camp, Adult education, Coaching classes for school children, Regular visit to the adopted villages.

During the NSS Special camp activities programmes the NSS Volunteers take data on school dropouts, Unemployment details, maternal delivery, formation of sports and cultural clubs and tree plantation. The NSS Volunteers collected data and sort out the problems.
